The following action steps are needed to start the **Bachelor of Counselling** programme:

- Determination of **Career Plan** (which direction)
- Deciding on a certain **degree programme**
- **Registration** with Calvary University (\$85)
- Selection of **courses** within the programme
- **Ordering** of first courses, textbooks and CD's

CU Registration

The Three Foundations:

The following action steps are needed to start the Bachelor of Counselling programme:

- Biblical Foundation (CLT courses)
- Bible-based Counselling (Many providers)
- Academic Foundation (Calvary courses)

Recognition of Prior Learning

The first two foundations may in many cases be recognised towards credits. Many students may already have completed a counselling course and/or a ministry or theology course in the past.

Two Qualifications

If the student prefers to do the Calvary Academic Foundation on its own in the form of qualifications, The following steps may be taken:

- Certificate in Psychology (123 Credits)
- Diploma in Counselling (+119 = 242 Credits)

The Diploma in Counselling (119 credits) includes the Certificate in Psychology (123 credits). If this is later added to the first two foundations, the student may then apply for a Bachelor of Counselling.

This Certificate and Diploma may be completed simultaneously but the qualifications will be issued when the prescribed number of credits have been completed – Certificate first, then Diploma.

Each of these qualifications will now be described.
