The following action steps are needed to start the **Bachelor of Ministry** programme:

- Determination of **Career Plan** (which direction)
- Deciding on a certain **degree programme**
- **Registration** with Calvary University (\$85)
- Selection of **courses** within the programme
- **Ordering** of first courses, textbooks and CD's

The Career Plan
